







Read or Listen: *Matthew 26:1-13*

The Jews Respond to JESUS - Tuesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: *Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.*

Read or Listen: *Matthew 26:14-25*

While Jesus was getting ready to celebrate the Passover meal with His disciples, Judas was getting ready to betray Jesus. To whom did Judas talk about getting rid of Jesus (v 14)?

What did Judas want more than the rule of Jesus (v 15)?

How many pieces of silver was Judas given? _____ This was the price of a slave in the Old Testament. Mary thought Jesus was more valuable than anything in the whole world, but Judas thought Jesus was good for nothing.

In the Gospel of John, we are told a little more about who ruled Judas' heart. *John 13:27 (ESV) —Then after he (Judas) had taken the morsel, S_____ entered into him. Jesus said to him, "What you are going to do, do quickly."*

The Jews Respond to JESUS – Wednesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: *Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.*

Read or Listen: *Matthew 26:26-29*

On this night, Jesus began the Lord's Supper. He changed the Passover feast into a celebration of a far greater event in history than the deliverance of Israel from slavery in Egypt. The Lord's Supper is a celebration of the deliverance of people from every nation in the world from the power and punishment of sin.

God commanded His followers to celebrate the Passover under the Old Testament law. Now, He was commanding His followers to celebrate Jesus Christ's death as the Passover Lamb in the New Testament of grace.

As Jesus broke the **b**_____ to share it with His disciples, He was showing that His **b**_____ would be broken to take God's wrath for their sin.

As Jesus passed the cup of **g**_____ **w**_____, He was showing that through the shedding of His **b**_____, His disciples would be totally forgiven of all sin.

Jesus also encouraged His disciples by saying that the next time He would drink of the grapevine, they would be with Him in God's palace! Someday, all of Jesus' disciples from the beginning of time will worship Him in His palace as the Passover Lamb.

The Jews Respond to JESUS - Thursday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: *Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.*

Read or Listen: *Matthew 26:30-35*

What did Jesus tell His disciples that they would do that night (v 31)? _____

Jesus was quoting the prophet Zechariah...

Zechariah 13:7 (ESV) – "Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, against the man who stands next to me," declares the LORD of hosts. Strike the s_____, and the s_____ will be s_____; I will turn my hand against the little ones."

Just as Zechariah had spoken many years before, Jesus' disciples would run away from Him in fear. Jesus also knew what was about to happen to Him. He knew that He would be betrayed, arrested, and eventually killed. Did Jesus know that He would be raised back to life again? YES NO

The Jews Respond to JESUS - Friday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: *Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.*

Read or Listen: *Matthew 26:36-46*

In the garden Jesus became extremely sad. We can't possibly begin to understand the weight of sin that He was about to bear. He did not fear man or the pain that He would experience physically. Rather, Jesus' sadness was due to the anger of God that He was about to bear for the sins of man.

As you studied the Old Testament, you saw many examples of the anger of God toward sin. Just to name a few...match the picture of God's anger toward sin with the reference where we find the story.
