STEPS TO INTERNATIONAL ADOPTION

- 1. Choose a home study agency.
- 2. Choose a placing agency.
- 3. Complete immigration requirements.
- 4. Paper chase (complete your dossier-paperwork required by foreign government) A dossier can include but *is not* limited to:
 Financial information, medical documents for each member of your family, tax information, employment letters, references from people who have known you longer than 5 years, police clearance, photos of your family and your home, bank letter, letter to the government stating why you want to adopt from their country.
- 5. Wait....and educate yourself!
- 6. Travel
- 7. Finalize your adoption in the States (unless your child came home on an IR-4 Visa, then you just wait for your Certificate of Citizenship that will arrive in the mail.)
