



## God Delivers Joseph - Monday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read or Listen:** *Genesis 39:20-23*

## God Delivers Joseph - Tuesday
