## God Floods the Earth - Monday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read or Listen:** *Genesis 6:1-8*

Adam lived 800 years after having Seth (v 4) and died about 250 years before Noah was born. This means Methuselah (along with all those born in between) could've heard about creation and the Fall from Adam!

Even though this was the case, what were people like in Noah's day (v 5)?

What part of man did God call wicked (v 5)?

Based upon what we learned in *Genesis 3*, if a man's heart is wicked, what else will be wicked (v 5; *James 1:14-15*)?

What was one way the people of Noah's day showed their rebellious hearts (v 2)?

Just like the sin of Adam and Eve, this sin brought death and separation from God. They deserved God's punishment. They enjoyed their sin, but what did God think about their sin (v 6)?

How was God going to punish them (v 7)?

Even though they deserved God's punishment, God showed grace to them. How did God show grace to them (v 3)?

God gave a promise that Eve's son would crush Satan. In these verses, it appears that God may not be able to keep His promise, and yet, we see that God had saved one man out of the whole earth, Noah. Will Noah crush Satan's rule? Next week, you'll learn the answer.

## God Floods the Earth - Tuesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read or Listen:** *Genesis 6:8-17*

How did Noah find favor with God (vv 8-9)?

This should remind us of Enoch (*Genesis 5*) who is described in the same way. As Enoch didn't die, so Noah will be saved from death because he walked with God. What other words are used to describe Noah (v 9)?

<i>Corrupt</i>	<i>Wicked heart</i>	<i>Violent</i>
<i>Righteous</i>	<i>Blameless</i>	

How were the rest of the people described (vv 11-12)?

How did Noah know to build a boat for safety from God's flood of judgment (v 13)?

How did Noah know how to build a boat that wouldn't sink (vv 14-18)?

What all would be destroyed in God's flood of judgment (v 17)?

*Everything that breathed*  
*Everything that was on the earth*  
*Only the wicked men*  
*Only the animals*

Every man was wicked and deserved God's judgment, including Noah, but God chose Noah to be a part of His plan for crushing Satan. God told Noah how he would be saved from God's wrath. Tomorrow, you'll see if Noah trusted God and obeyed His instructions.

Just like Noah, we all are sinners deserving God's judgment, but God has shown us in His Word how we can be saved from God's wrath, too. Are you trusting God to save you from your sins and His wrath? Will you trust Him all your life, so that you'll be saved from His eternal judgment?

## God Floods the Earth - Wednesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read or Listen:** *Genesis 6:18-22*

God made a promise to Adam and Eve that one of Eve's sons would crush Satan. With the whole earth being so wicked, it seems that God's promise may not come to pass. Then, Noah is described as different than everyone else, that he walked with God.

In *verse 18*, we see why Noah was different from everyone else. It wasn't because Noah was perfect, but because of something God did. What did God do (*v 18*)?

"I will e\_\_\_\_\_ My c\_\_\_\_\_ with you."

Look up what this word means, "covenant" (*Following Jesus Bible, p 1377*): \_\_\_\_\_

God made a promise to Noah that through Noah, His promise to Adam and Eve would come to pass. Who else did God promise to save with Noah (*vv 18-19*)? "w\_\_\_\_\_, s\_\_\_\_\_, s\_\_\_\_\_'s w\_\_\_\_\_, two of every l\_\_\_\_\_ th\_\_\_\_\_"

Why did God save all these things (*v 20*)?

Noah was told to build the boat, but what else did Noah need to do (*v 21*)? "st\_\_\_\_\_ up f\_\_\_\_\_"

God pointed out man's sin. God promised punishment. God told Noah how he could be saved. God told Noah what he needed to do if he believed God's words and trusted in God's salvation. Did Noah obey God in faith (*v 22*)? Yes No

How much of what God commanded did Noah do (*v 22*)? \_\_\_\_\_

If you believe God's Word is true about your sin, His wrath, and His salvation, you will live in obedience to God's Word by faith, too.

## God Floods the Earth - Thursday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read or Listen:** *Genesis 7:1-10*

Noah built the ark just as God commanded him. Noah stored the food just as God commanded him. Now, the time had come for God to send the flood upon the earth. God gave people 120 years to turn from their wicked ways.

How many people are called righteous by God (v 1)?

How many turned from their wicked ways (v 1)?

God does not say Noah's sons and their wives were righteous, yet what did God tell Noah to do with his family (v 1)?

God told Noah to take a male and female of every animal on the ark and 7 pairs of some animals. What did God call the 7 paired animals (v 2)? \_\_\_\_\_

Moses is writing this book for the Israelites around the time that Exodus-Numbers were taking place. Even though God hadn't given the Law on clean animals in Noah's day, those reading this story would understand the clean animals to be animals that they could eat. Wait a minute... select everything in creation that Adam ate for food (*Genesis 2:29*): *Plants      Animals      Vegetables      Fruit*

If God told man to eat plants before the flood, why would Noah need to take extra animals that were clean (*Genesis 9:3*)?

Did Noah go into the ark as God commanded (v 5)?    Yes    No

Did Noah take his family as God commanded (v 6)?    Yes    No

Did Noah take the animals as God commanded (v 8)?    Yes    No

Did God send the rain as He promised (v 10)?    Yes    No

Noah believed God, obeyed God by faith, and as a result, his whole family was saved. Enoch worshiped God and led others to call upon the Lord.

In a similar way, God has called your parents to lead you to believe God and call upon Him to be saved. When your parents obey God, it gives you the opportunity to learn about God and call upon Him to be saved, too. Will you follow your parents' example and call upon the Lord?

## God Floods the Earth - Friday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read or Listen:** *Genesis 7:11-16*

When God flooded the earth, it was as if He was starting over with creation. How does the flood "undo" part of the works of creation (*Genesis 1:2, 6, 9, 11; 7:11*)?

God sent 40 days and nights of rain like He said.

God protected Noah and his family like He said.

God protected the animals in the ark like He said.

Noah obeyed God's instructions trusting in God's salvation.

The animals followed God's instructions.

Noah shut the door, so no life in the ark would be lost.

Yes, God called Noah out of the wicked world to be saved. Yes, God only saved enough animals to keep them alive on the earth. Yes, Noah needed to obey God's instructions to be saved, but in the end, GOD shut and sealed the door so no life would be lost on the ark.

God still calls people out of this wicked world to be saved. Part of that call is a command to repent of sin, but one can only be saved from sin if God gives them new life in His Son and seals them with His Spirit.

We are all deserving of God's flood of wrath, but He calls us to turn to Him away from our sin. Will you listen to Him and obey? Are you listening to Him and obeying? If you are, thank Him for the new life He is giving to you!

## God Floods the Earth - Saturday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read or Listen:** *Genesis 7:17-24*

This was a sad day in history. In *Genesis 1-2*, everything in the universe is seen as very good, a paradise, and everything following God's voice. Then, it all goes very badly as we read in *Genesis 3-6*. Now, the earth is covered by water with a lonely boat in which are 8 people, a bunch of animals, and a bunch of plants for food. For 150 days, that boat is bobbing on the water all alone on the flooded earth.

God promised both punishment and salvation, but in the end, only one man is described by God as being righteous. God will start over with that one man, a kind of 2<sup>nd</sup> Adam. So far, he has done everything God commanded him to do, and it appears that he is ruling over the animals. Would he do better than Adam? Would he be the seed of Eve who would crush Satan's rule? We'll find out next week!
