**Unit 11 = The God Who Saves**  
**Unit 11 Answer—It is God’s free gift!**

Ephesians 2:8–9 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

**Big Idea 60—The Holy Spirit changes our hearts so we can be saved.**

Titus 3:5 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>5</sup> He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit.

**Big Idea 57—God saves sinners who confess their sins.**

1 John 1:9 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Unit 12 = God’s People Live for Him**  
**Unit 12 Answer—They should live like Jesus!**

Ephesians 5:1–2 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>1</sup> Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. <sup>2</sup> And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

**Big Idea 58—Jesus is the only way to be saved.**

John 14:6 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>6</sup> Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”

**Big Idea 61—God’s people grow to be more like Jesus.**

2 Corinthians 3:18 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>18</sup> And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another.

**Big Idea 59—We must trust Jesus as our Savior.**

Romans 10:9 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>9</sup> If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

**Big Idea 62—God’s people love Him with all their being.**

Deuteronomy 6:5 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>5</sup> You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

**Big Idea 63—God’s people love others.**

1 John 4:20 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>20</sup> If anyone says, “I love God,” and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen.

**Big Idea 67—God’s people work for Him.**

Ephesians 2:10 <sup>(ESV)</sup> —<sup>10</sup> For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

**Big Idea 64—God’s people trust Him.**

Proverbs 3:5–6 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

**Big Idea 65—God’s people are good stewards of His gifts.**

1 Peter 4:10 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>10</sup> As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God’s varied grace.

**Big Idea 66—God’s people obey Him.**

John 14:23 <sup>(ESV)</sup> — <sup>23</sup> Jesus answered him, “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.”

**Psalm 23** <sup>(ESV)</sup> (50 pts)

<sup>1</sup> The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

<sup>2</sup> He makes me lie down in green pastures.

He leads me beside still waters.

<sup>3</sup> He restores my soul.

He leads me in paths of righteousness  
for his name's sake.

<sup>4</sup> Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,

I will fear no evil,

for you are with me;

your rod and your staff,

they comfort me.

<sup>5</sup> You prepare a table before me

in the presence of my enemies;

you anoint my head with oil;

my cup overflows.

<sup>6</sup> Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me

all the days of my life,

and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD

forever.

**Matthew 6:9–13** <sup>(ESV)</sup> – Jesus' Prayer (50 pts)

<sup>9</sup> Pray then like this:

“Our Father in heaven,

hallowed be your name.

<sup>10</sup> Your kingdom come,

your will be done,

on earth as it is in heaven.

<sup>11</sup> Give us this day our daily bread,

<sup>12</sup> and forgive us our debts,

as we also have forgiven our debtors.

<sup>13</sup> And lead us not into temptation,

but deliver us from evil.”

**Acts 1:4–11** <sup>(ESV)</sup> – Jesus' Ascension (75 pts)

<sup>4</sup> And while staying with them he ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, “you heard from me; <sup>5</sup> for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”

<sup>6</sup> So when they had come together, they asked him, “Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?” <sup>7</sup> He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. <sup>8</sup> But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” <sup>9</sup> And when he had said these things, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. <sup>10</sup> And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, <sup>11</sup> and said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven.”

**Galatians 5:22-23** <sup>(ESV)</sup> – Fruit of the Spirit (10 pts)

<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.
